The 2nd Millsaps Champions Camp will be held June 8- 12, Monday-Friday for ages 10 - 15 at Millsaps College. Camps hours Monday - Thursday are 8:30 a.m.- 4 p.m. **Camp ends at 2 p.m. on Friday.** Tuition is \$185.00.

The 3rd Millsaps Champions Camp will be held July 13 - 17, Monday - Friday for ages 5 - 15 at Millsaps College. Camp hours Monday - Thursday are 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m. **Camp ends at 2 p.m. on Friday.** Tuition is \$185.00.
